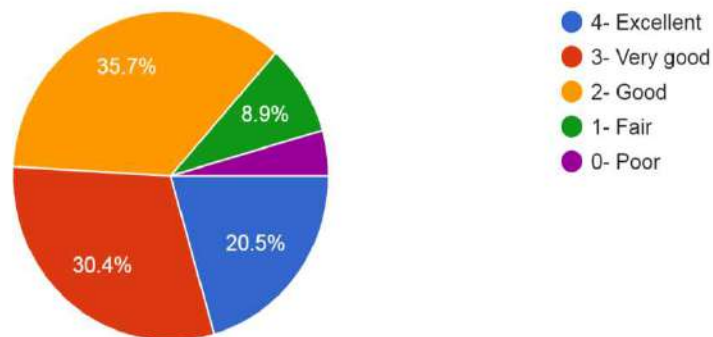

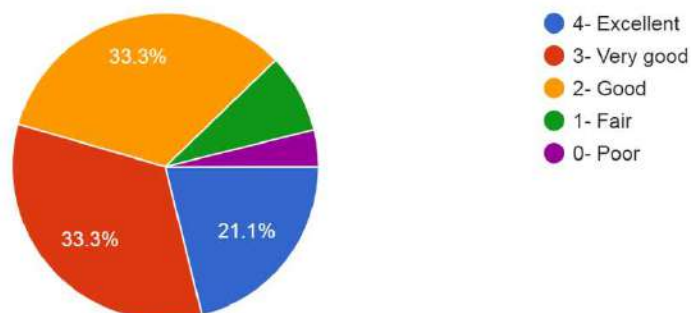
How do you rate Programme in terms of the curriculum syllabi in different semesters?

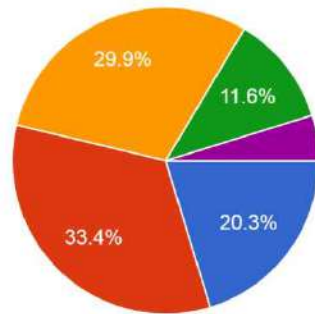
How do you rate the quality and relevance of the courses included in the curriculum?

How do you rate courses in terms of their relevance to the latest and/ or future technologies?

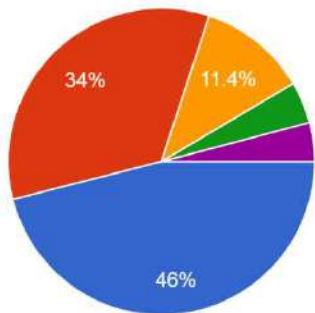

How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

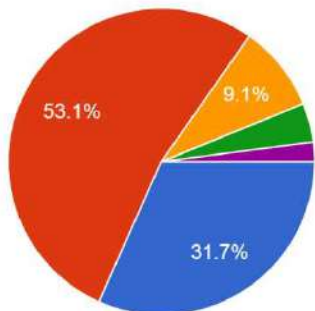

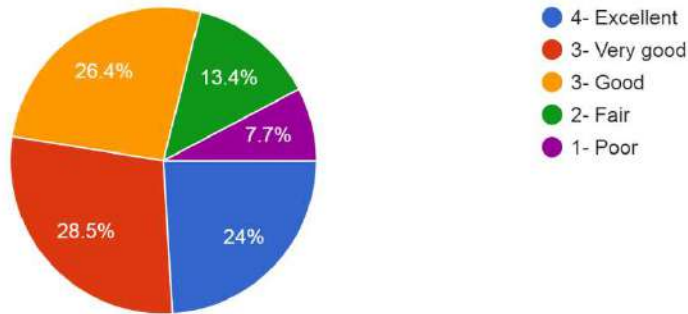

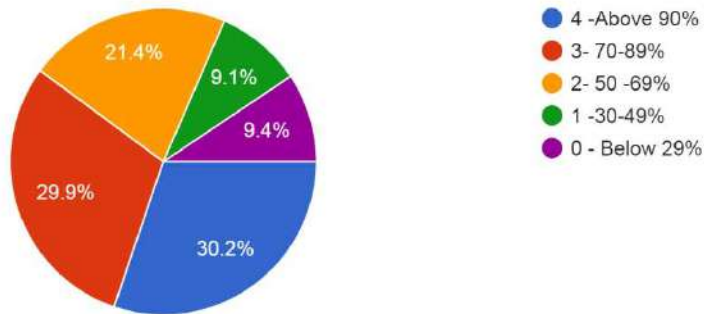
How do you rate the availability of the text and reference books in the library?

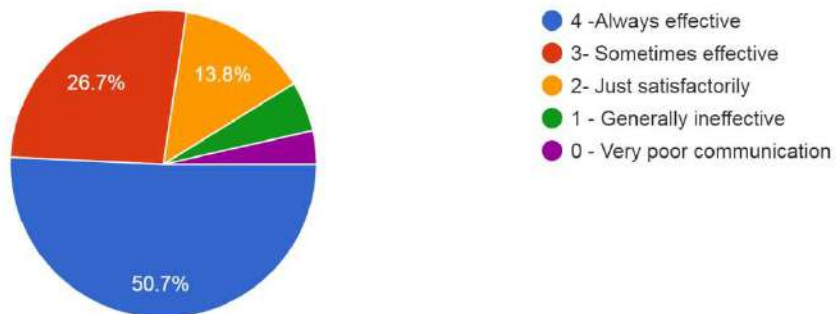
What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc, while teaching.

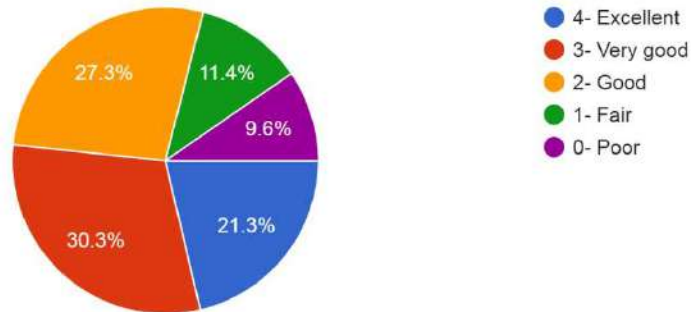

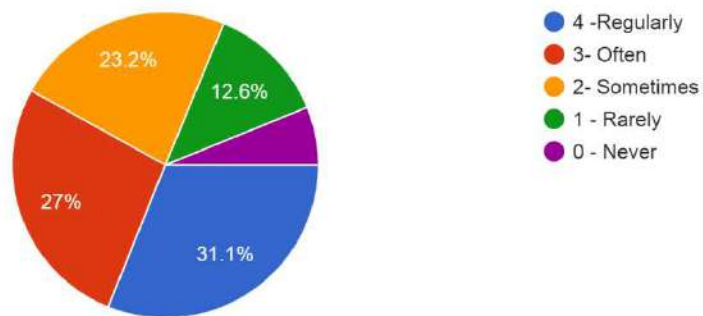
How do you rate University activities that help in getting jobs and placements?

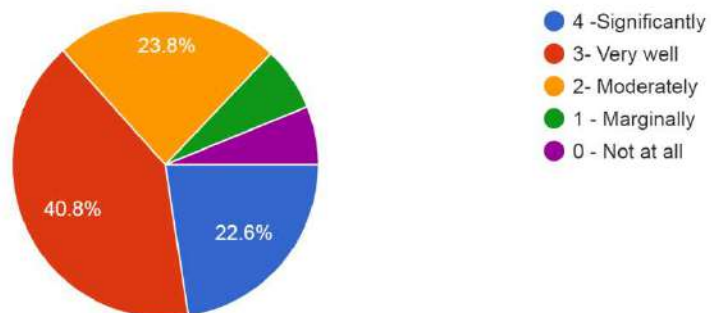

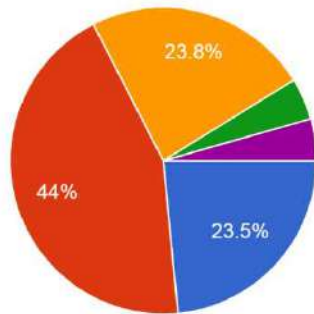

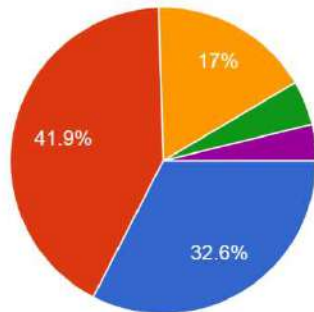

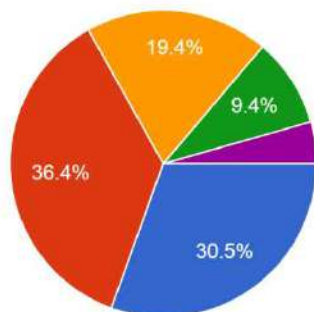

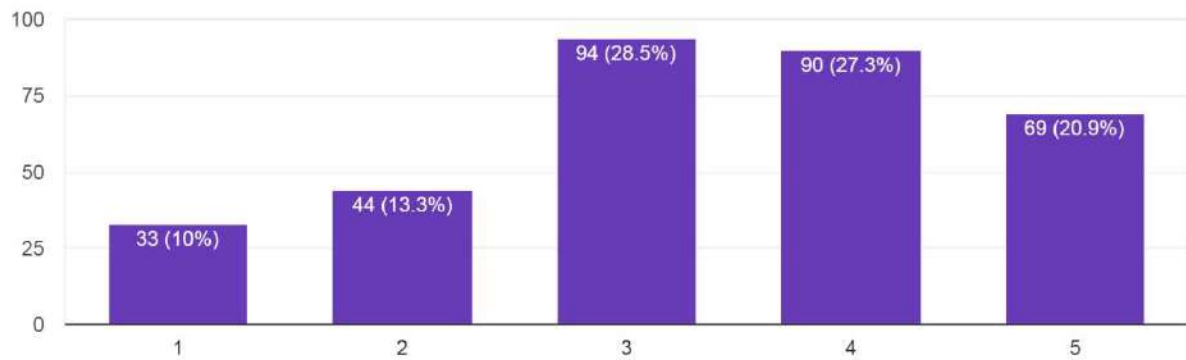
