IQAC MEETINGS 2022-23

Minutes of Meetings

1. July 13, 2022

Minutes of the discussion are as follows: -

In the first meeting of the IQAC for the session 2022–23, Prof. Preeti Mehta (Director IQAC) welcomed the meeting's chairperson, honourable President Prof. Karunesh Saxena, registrar Prof. Rajeev Mehta, and invited external members Lt.Dr. M. Satyanarayan, Prof. Deepak Jaroliya, Mr. Anoop Kumar Somani, Deans, and IQAC Committee members.

- Meeting is followed by Sangam Kulgeet.
- Prof. Preeti Mehta (Director IQAC) delivered the agenda items and Action taken report for the IQAC session 2021–2022.

Developments Communicated

The following measures, which were discussed in the previous meeting on May 6, 2022, were confirmed.

- Before June 10, 2022, all schools held Board of Studies meetings where they recommended curriculum changes and the integration of NEP-2020 recommendations.
- On July 16, 2022, Training & Placement will host the Industry-Academia Meet and invite industry leaders from all sectors.
- Deans and administrative heads have received the academic and administrative audit standards and proforma from IQAC.
- The Interdisciplinary International Conference is scheduled for August 26–28, 2022. The committee is ready.
 - The chairperson recommended that internal meetings for IQAC members be held more frequently while the committee's meetings should meet twice each semester. All committee members must receive the meeting agenda and the action report of the prior meeting at least ten to fifteen days in advance.
 - By planning more events and enlisting more students, student clubs should be revitalised and strengthened.
 - Keep focus on best practices the entire academic year.
 - Internal and external academic and administrative audits should be organized and carried out once a year.

- SU AQAR 2020-21 must be filed by July 25, 2022, or earlier.
 1. President sir congratulate the IQAC IIRF Team for their great performance in IIRF Ranking. Sangam University scored 6th Rank in Rajasthan, 24th Rank in North zone and 45th rank in India among emerging private Universities.
 2. Ask all deans review their COs and POs and change them in accordance with Bloom's Taxonomy levels.
 3. Curriculum should be enriched according to the NEP2020 Guidelines.
 4. Implementation of Outcome based education and attainments of Program and Course outcomes via evaluation process. All Deans and heads are asked to prepare at least one course of each program as pilot course for the achievement of CO-PO attainment.
 5. Development of Centralize Entrepreneurship Cell.
 6. Agriculture projects / training can be provided to nearby villagers to promote skill development under NABARD projects.
 7. The Tejaswini Project is coordinated by the Women Empowerment Cell, which also plans other initiatives aimed at empowering women.
 8. Sanitary vending machine allocation is imminent.
 9. Engage the NCC, NSS, and other women's empowerment cell faculty and students to spread the word about the Tejaswini Project and to plan events or sessions for the local women's and girls' groups in adjacent communities. (like send students to villages to provide education, volunteer teaching activity. Provide sewing machines and teach them basics, sessions for life skills etc.)
 10. External members Prof. M. Satynarayan, Prof. Deepak Jaroliya gave their concluding remarks.
 11. Once a week, IQAC & deans should convene informal meetings of the schools to discuss academic activities, student-related planning, and other matters.
 12. Introducing the idea of quality champions will inspire faculty and staff. (Each one should be given a badge for his/her quality work for a period of time)
 13. By 20 August 2022, President Sir shall have completed the Sangam University's Comprehensive Strategic Plan.
 14. Update the university's vision and mission by August 15, 2022.
 15. Consult experts and alumni for their thoughts on the vision and mission.
 16. The creation of quality manuals and policies is required. Use a Quality manual as an Umbrella document.

- The Student handbook needs to be revised.
 - Examination, Research and Mentoring manuals shall be prepared in booklet form.
 - The H.R manual will be revisited soon.
17. Document what you are doing & Do what you have documented.
 18. Members shall be added under Training & Placement for the Incubation center (Dedicated person). Separate center for Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship.
 19. Promote Industry Academia meet on social media platforms and tag the industries its officials and resource persons.
 20. Include alumni in startups & provide consultancies.
 21. Start student oriented projects - Startups.
 22. Market Sangam University as resource center for MDP & SDP.
 23. Three IPR workshops will be organized:
 - By IQAC
 - By Law department
 - By Management Department
 24. Plan Gender Audit Yearly.
 25. Scholarship schemes for single girl children should be promoted & applied under the UGC scheme.
 26. School Blogs shall be created & uploaded on the website.
 27. Emblem for IQAC shall be designed.
 28. Academic Audit every year is compulsory.
 29. A Capacity Building Center (CBC) will be established. The placement cell under CBC should provide students with psychological and career advice. All the student related activities should be integrated into the time table.
 30. Form quality circles and carry out activities in them for best practices.

2. December 21, 2022

6. NIRF Data submission of Overall University + Agriculture Science is by January 6, 2023. Committee of NIRF Agriculture Science will include all faculty members of SOAST & will work under the guidance of Prof. (Dr.) Preeti Mehta. For Data preparation committee members will work in winter break.
7. Send SU Newsletter Pratibimb to all Stakeholders (Alumni + Industry Experts) to create perception of the university.
8. Project Proposal Committee for the University is formed which includes:
A training program on Project Proposals themed as “What is a good proposal and How it can be Granted” will be jointly organized by IQAC & CESD taken by Honorable President Prof. (Dr.) Karunesh Saxena in January, 2023..
9. Research Management System will be introduced and updated on website after discussion with expert Prof. RS Rai and Dr. Vikas Somani.
10. All the faculty members should have their Google Scholar Profile & Research Gate Profile registered by the end of December, 2022.
11. 1 year duration courses can be counted as EDP (Executive Development Programs).
12. MDP (Management Development Programs) shall be introduced.
13. Frequency of meetings of the IQAC Committee shall be increased.
14. Skill Development Center under the CESD shall be started for certification programs.

15. Paperless Exam concept should be introduced as early as possible. Change in exam question paper format. Online MID Sems Exams and only Objective question pattern for MID Semester Exam and Theoretical question paper for the End Term Exams.
16. Each school should have a budget for extension lectures.
17. Convocation will be on February 8, 2023 & LA-UNION 2023 will be on February, 10-11 2023.
18. Introduce classes and workshops for schools. Call motivational speakers for the students under the head of IQAC.
19. Even semester buses for students will be leaving at 4:30PM. Arrange for club activities from 2:30PM - 4:30PM.

4. Institutional development plan was discussed.

5. Research - Central Instrumentation lab should be developed.
6. Exam - 50% of answer sheets should go to external for checking & question papers also from external. 50% of assignments should be practical oriented.
7. Training & Placement Cell - Career Counseling Sessions for developing the mindset of students and separate cells for more activities regarding career counseling should be formed. Industry Oriented programs to be conducted for students to gain practical knowledge of the market and industry.
8. The Research Directorate agreed and stated a Career counseling cell for a broader area of students is needed.
9. Dean SOMS - Skills required for marking industries shall be practiced through skill based education to showcase it in the market.
10. Dr. Tanuja - Internship programs for 6 months including field survey, major research projects, etc.
11. Director IQAC - Each year Internship programs shall be introduced and implemented.
12. Dr. Jorawar - Certificate courses for skill development and vocational programs need to be started.
13. Prof. K.K. Sharma - Foreign language certificate courses shall be introduced for students.
14. Dr. Tikam Chand Dakal - Bio-incubation center should be started, Design small certificate courses in the field of Biotechnology, Microbiology, etc. More extension activities and lectures can be conducted to influence students, Summer - winter short courses, Regional basis importance courses need to be added.
15. Dr. Seema Kabra - Summer internships for students to gain practical experience during their course duration, SSS is very important so faculty should be assigned in each school to guide the students.
16. Lt. Dr. M. Satyanarayana - Student exchange programs , Department level strategic plans, Capacity building center for Career Counseling of Students, Each school should have Co-coordinator of NAAC- IQAC & sub coordinators of each criteria. Internal observer's in criterion heads, Student activity tab should be on the website, Customized software for document compilation needed.
