



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR THE ACADEMIC COOPERATION between

KYUNGDONG UNIVERSITY and

SANGAM UNIVERSITY

Kyungdong University (KDU), 46 Bongpo-4-Gil, Goseong-gun, Gangwondo, South Korea and Sangam University (SU), Bhilwara, Rajasthan, India, recognizing the value of international cooperation, hereby agree upon the following terms and conditions for Agreement for the academic cooperation which consists of the following activities: exchange of students, exchange of faculty and researchers,

I. EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS

Student exchanges work as follows for KDU (the same principle applied by Sangam University):

- KDU offers a variety of scholarships based on the academic merits of each students and the remaining KDU Tuition fees after scholarships are as follows:
 - \$3500 after 30% scholarship for 75-79 average mark
 - \$2500 after 50% scholarship for 80-89 average mark
 - \$1500 after 70% scholarship or 90-94 average mark
 - o Nil after 100% scholarship for over 95 average mark
- Sangam University provides the same scholarship for each semester as that of KDU.
 The remaining balance of the Sangam University's tuition fee will be paid by KDU from the fee paid by student.
- Students are responsible for the initial expenses such as airfare, application fee, dormitory, health insurance and so on.
- KDU support students for job search.

1. SELECTION OF PARTICIPANTS

The program is open to undergraduate students who have completed at least one year of undergraduate study at the home institute. Participating students will be selected by the home institute generally on the basis of academic merit. It is understood that the host institute reserves the right to make a final decision on the admission of students nominated for the student exchange program.

In case the candidate should be rejected by the host institute for any reason, the home institute may nominate alternative candidates for consideration by the host institute. Home institute will be responsible to assure that the students selected for the exchange display sufficient proficiency in the language appropriate to the host institute to carry out their studies and research at the host institute.

2. ELIGIBLE COURSES AND CREDIT TRANSFER

Each participating student will take courses offered at the host institute. Academic credits earned at the host institute may be transferred back to the home institute in accordance with procedures determined by the home institute.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES

Each participating student will enjoy the same rights and privileges as students at the host institution and be subject to the regulations and discipline of the host institute and country. The institutes will provide each other with adequate information on the performance of participating students and each institution will nominate a member of staff to coordinate the programs.

Each institution will be responsible for maintaining student records for its programmes and will send copies of transcripts for all students who successfully complete the programme under the terms of this agreement.

4. ACCOMMODATION

Both institutes agree to help the participating students find relevant housing accommodations.

5. FINANCE

The payment of such housing, together with the payment for travel, visa, medical insurance and sustenance costs, shall be the responsibility of the individual student participating in the program and neither institution shall be held liable for such charges and arrangements.

6. HEALTH INSURANCE

Each participating student is required to purchase adequate medical insurance in accordance with the regulations of relevant countries.

II. EXCHANGE OF FACULTY AND RESEARCHERS:

With the objective of strengthening ties through joint projects and activities of both universities, the agreement allows for the creation of faculty and researcher exchange. The following conditions will apply:

- 1. The professors and researchers will maintain their status as faculty members at their home institute for the duration of the exchange.
- 2. The appropriate academic departments and administrative offices will assist in securing housing and other necessary arrangements for living in the host institute's city.

III. JOINT RESEARCH AND RESOURCES SHARING

Both institution agree to promote joint research and realize collaborative projects. Both parties may share financial resources necessary for the completion of joint programs.

IV. TERM OF VALIDITY, RENEWAL, AMENDMENT, AND TERMINATION

This Agreement shall commence on the date when the representatives of both institutes affix their signatures and shall continue thereafter for five (5) years subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement. Either insitute may, by notice in writing of no less than six (6) months, terminate this Agreement but any participating students who have commenced at either institute, or wose exchange procedures have been started by the date of termination, may complete their courses of study. The institutes will confer concerning the renewal of this Agreement six (6) months prior to its expiration.
