CURRICULUM CHANGES

As per UGC-NHEQF and State Task Force for NEP (STEN) Implementation (State Higher Education (Group-IV) Department), Government of Rajasthan directions, it is resolved to implement the NHEQF framework from First Semester (July 2023) of B.A. and Post Graduate programmes and design syllabi of prescribed minimum credit framework.

It is resolved that AECC courses for UG in SOAH will be uniform in the University and it is unanimously decided that AECC for Semester-I will be English Grammar and Communication and for Semester-II will be Environmental Science. The Course and Scheme will be frame by SOAH in time.






