Beyond Legislation: The Reality of Abortion Rights in India

In a country where reproductive rights are often debated, India's abortion laws have undergone significant changes to balance legal frameworks with women's autonomy. The Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act (MTPA), first enacted in 1971, marked a crucial step toward recognizing reproductive health rights. However, despite legal provisions allowing abortion under specific circumstances, challenges persist, particularly in rural areas where access to safe abortion remains limited. India's abortion laws have evolved over the years to provide greater autonomy to women. The MTPA permits abortion under specific conditions, including when the pregnancy poses a risk to the woman's life, when there are fetal abnormalities, or in cases of rape and incest. Recent amendments to the Act in 2021 further expanded access by extending the gestational limit to 24 weeks for certain categories of women, such as survivors of sexual assault and minors.

The law also decriminalized abortion for unmarried women, ensuring more inclusivity in reproductive rights. Despite these legal advancements, many women, particularly in rural India, face difficulties in accessing abortion services due to stigma, lack of healthcare facilities, and restrictive interpretations of the law by medical practitioners. While the MTPA provides a legal framework for abortion, the ground reality differs significantly. Studies indicate that a large percentage of abortions in India are still conducted outside legal medical facilities, increasing the risk of unsafe procedures and maternal mortality. Limited awareness, societal pressure, and inadequate healthcare infrastructure contribute to this issue. The requirement of medical professionals' approval for abortion can also create barriers. In many cases, women are forced to seek unsafe options due to delays or refusal from healthcare providers, especially in conservative regions. The lack of trained professionals in remote areas further exacerbates the problem. Cultural stigmas associated with abortion remain a major concern in India. Many women, particularly unmarried women or those from conservative backgrounds, face social ostracization for seeking abortions.

The fear of judgment often prevents them from accessing proper medical care, pushing them toward unregulated and unsafe practices. Furthermore, sex-selective abortions remain a serious issue in India, despite the Pre Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (PCPNDT) Act, which prohibits gender-based abortions. Authorities have struggled to curb illegal practices, and the enforcement of the law remains inconsistent. India's abortion laws are progressive compared to many other countries, but implementation challenges need urgent attention. Expanding awareness about legal rights, ensuring better healthcare infrastructure, and training more medical professionals to provide safe abortion services can help bridge the gap between policy and practice. Policymakers must focus on destigmatizing abortion through education and public awareness campaigns. Additionally, further reforms could provide women with more autonomy by reducing the bureaucratic hurdles involved in obtaining legal abortions. As India continues to evolve, ensuring safe and accessible abortion services is crucial in upholding women's rights and public health. The journey towards complete reproductive freedom is ongoing, but with continued reforms and awareness, the country can take significant strides in ensuring every woman has the right to make decisions about her own body.

One-Day National Workshop on New Criminal Laws

The School of Legal Studies at Sangam University organized a *One-Day National Workshop on New Criminal Laws* on 26th July 2024. This workshop aimed to enlighten the faculty, staff, and students about the latest developments in the Indian legal framework in three major criminal laws: The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023, The Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023, and The Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam 2023.

The Chief Guest, *Mr. Vishal Bhargav, Additional District Judge and Secretary of the District Legal Services Authority*, discussed the importance of changes in criminal law and highlighted the relevance of these changes to judicial processes and their potential impact on justice delivery. The workshop's distinguished guest, *Mr. Shiv Kumar Sharma, Retired District Judge*, provided guidance on the amendments in the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) and addressed how it aims to create a more responsive legal framework. *Advocate Mr. Rishi Tiwari, President Bhilwara Bar Association*, also shared his insights on the new laws. He motivated the future generation of lawyers to be proactive in their roles, ensuring they contribute to a fair and just society.

The technical sessions began with *Dr. Shweta Singh from Symbiosis School of Law, Pune*, was the workshop's first speaker. She shared her views on the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 and emphasized innovations and reforms in the legal system. The second speaker, *Dr. Anu Solanki, Advocate at the Supreme Court of India*, discussed the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (BNS) and highlighted critical points regarding reforms in the judicial system. The workshop concluded with an interactive Q&A session, leaving participants with a deeper understanding of the evolving landscape of Indian criminal law


