- The paper should be original and being presented for the first time.
- A written declaration about the originality of the work from the Author(s) should be sent along with the paper in the prescribed format.
- The paper should be clearly typed and should not exceed 6000 words.
- Use Times New Roman 12 size font with 1.5 line spacing.
- All the registered delegates will get certificate of participation/presentation.

## Advisory

- The list of themes is not exhaustive, papers related to the soul of the conference may be accepted.
- Papers will be reviewed blindly by a panel of experts.
- Papers should adhere to the submission guidelines given for the conference.
- Separate fee will be charged for more than one paper.
- Letter of acceptance of abstract shall be sent on the email address of the authors.
- Registration form has to be compulsorily submitted for the consideration of participation in the conference.
- Schedule of the tracks and technical sessions will be shared after the confirmation of registration.
- Only presented papers will be considered for publication.
