Minutes of the NIRF Committee Meeting

A meeting of the NIRF Committee members along with the concerned Deans and Heads was held on 08 January 2026 at 3:45 PM in the Pro-President's Office, as per the directions of the Hon'ble President Sir. The meeting was coordinated by Prof. (Dr.) Preeti Mehta, Director IQAC.

Discussions

- The Director IQAC informed the members that Sangam University has submitted its application for NIRF Ranking 2025–26 under the University category and for its constituent Schools, namely:
 - School of Engineering (SOET)
 - School of Management Studies (SOMS)
 - School of Agriculture Science & Technology (SOAST)
- The previous year's NIRF report and data framework were shared with all members to provide clarity on parameters, benchmarks, and documentation requirements.
- A detailed discussion was held on the collection of NIRF data from various functional departments, including: HR, Student Section, Accounts/Finance, Research Cell, Concerned Schools and Departments
- The Director IQAC emphasized the importance of accuracy, consistency, and timely submission of data as per NIRF guidelines.
- It was decided that all concerned departments must compile and submit the required NIRF data to IQAC on or before 22 January 2026.
- The members were informed that timely submission of departmental data is essential to ensure consolidation and final submission of overall University data, especially after the successful submission of data by SOET, SOAST, and SOMS.
